Wine of Origin Elgin

The Uncensored Version – a project of heart and passion by Bobby Wallace

This is the seventh vintage, produced from a small parcel of Chenin Blanc grapes sourced from within the cool-climate district of Elgin.

Chenin Blanc is something of a rarity in Elgin and 2024 being a very low cropping year with only 1850 bottles of the Off the Record Chenin Blanc 2024 were produced.

DESCRIPTION

The wine has an attractive pale straw colour. The nose leads with appealing citrus notes, which unfold onto the palate with a rich, creamy mouthfeel. The broad spectrum of citrus, underlying minerality and gentle wooding have contributed to the complexity of this Chenin Blanc and culminate in a long lingering finish.

WINEMAKING

Wild ferment and barrel aged for 10 months in a mixture of 1^{st} fill(10%), 2^{nd} , 3^{rd} & 4^{th} fill barriques. The wine underwent partial malolactic fermentation in barrel. No added enzymes, yeast and fining agents were used in the making of this wine.
